Understanding Your Options



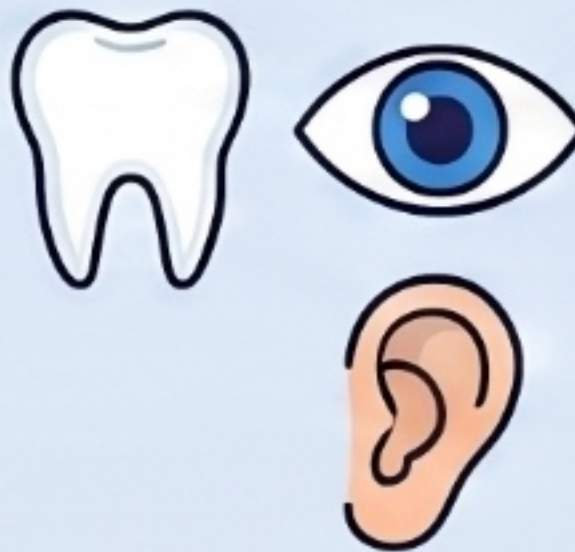
The Two General Paths
Choose Medicare Advantage for bundling or Original Medicare with a Supplement for broader flexibility.



Local Network Matters
Your choice should be driven by whether your specific Knoxville doctors are in-network.



Cost vs. Predictability
Decide between lower monthly premiums with more variability or higher premiums with fewer surprise bills.
